CRAIG COUNTY RECREATIONAL ELECTRIC SERVICE POLICY

A vacant parcel is permitted to install recreational electric service under the following conditions:

- 1. The vacant parcel is greater than seven (7) acres
- No more than one (1) travel trailer, motor home or other similar recreational
 vehicle will be permitted on the parcel at the same time and shall not be used as a
 long term residence
- Any structure intended for living purposes, whether short term or long term, will
 meet the requirements of the Building Code, Zoning Ordinance and Virginia
 Department of Health regulations
- 4. Any structure constructed on the parcel will require a building permit and zoning clearance
- 5. Short term is defined as a period of time up to two weeks and long term is more than two weeks
- 6. Permanent is considered more than sixty (60) days

In the event a violation of this policy is determined to exist where a recreational electric service has been permitted, the Building Official is authorized to terminate the service by notification to the appropriate electric service provider and the electric service provider shall terminate the service.

The Board of Supervisors of Craig County, in a regular meeting on the 7^{th} day of August, 2014 adopted this Resolution.
