**Sec. 34-1. Permit required.**

It shall be unlawful for any person who does not possess an unrevoked permit from the board of supervisors to engage in the business of refuse collection or refuse disposal for compensation in the county. The board of supervisors shall issue permits for such applicants, provided that such permits shall be limited to persons having proper equipment and personnel to collect and dispose of refuse.

**Sec. 34-2. Fee.**

The fee for such a permit shall be established by the board of supervisors, and all permits shall be issued for the calendar year or such portion thereof as shall remain after the issuance of the permit. There shall be no reduction in the fee for a permit issued after the beginning of any calendar year.

**Sec. 34-3. Application.**

Every person desiring to engage in the collection of refuse shall make a written application to the board of supervisors, setting forth the name of such person, the resident address thereof or the address of the place of business, a description of the equipment to be used, and the precise area to be served.

**Sec. 34-4. Vehicle requirements.**

All vehicles used for collection of refuse shall be equipped with an enclosed cargo space or with fabricated sides, ends, and cover suitable to prevent scattering of trash from the vehicle and the enclosed cargo space or cover shall be securely fastened at all times except when the vehicle is being loaded or unloaded.

**Sec. 34-5. Scattering of waste and trash.**

Waste and trash material shall not be scattered at the places of collection or upon any street, walkway, or alley, nor shall such trash or waste material be left in such condition that it may be scattered by other persons, animals, or natural causes.

**Sec. 34-6. Revocation of permit.**

Violation of the requirements of this chapter shall be sufficient cause for immediate revocation of the permit to engage in the business of refuse collection.
