WHEREAS, it is the request of the Craig County Emergency Services Dept for a transfer from contingency of 2,105 for a correction to salaries and benefits be made, this is for two employees and benefits, and

WHEREAS, the Craig County Sheriff Office has collected donations for the Hooked-on Fishing event in the amount of \$2,350, this will be place in the specific line item for the cost of the event for the children, and

WHEREAS, the Tourism Commission has been working on the reprinting of the Craig Co 911 maps, they have collections in the amount of \$1,350 from patrons for the advertisements, these funds will be used for the expense of printing the maps, and

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Department has received reimbursement funding for Ashe training in the amount of \$180, this will be used for additional training for our communities needs, and

WHEREAS, the Craig County Emergency Services(CCEMS) has also received donations from memorials from citizens in the amount of \$ 419, these funds have been sent to CCEMS in memory of a loved one and these will be placed into a specific line item in the CCEMS budget and used specifically for EMS equipment, and

WHEREAS, the Circuit Court has received a records preservation grant in the amount of \$13,840 for digitizing land books this will be used for the cost of the processing of these records, and the Circuit Court Clerk has also received reimbursement for postage for mailing off passport applications in the amount of \$73 this will be added to the postage in that department, and

WHEREAS, the Treasurer has received additional revenue above the budget revenue for DMV stops \$2,335 and also for Credit Card Charges in the amount of \$432, these will be also placed in the expense line to pay for the charges on these items, and
