OPEN MEETING

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mr. Spence.

PUBLIC HEARING

A joint public hearing with the Planning Commission for comment on “Use Not Provided For”, Corie Trivette Mud Bog Event to take place at County Campgrounds, June 18th and August 27th, 2022 starting at 12 noon to 10 pm.

Mr. Spence asked the Board if there were any comments before opening the public hearing. There was no comment from Board.

Mr. Klopfer opened the public hearing at 6:02 pm.
Mr. Collins asked Mr. Trivette to come to the podium.

Mr. Trivette said he has been organizing Mud Bog events like this for about 5 years and enjoyed these types of events as a child and teenager. Mr. Trivette would like to make this a yearly activity. Mr. Joyce asked about the time of the event concerned about the noise level. Mr. Trivette explained that the event would end at 10 pm following the County noise ordinance. He explained the that loud classes will be first starting at around 12 noon. Towards the end will be the cars that are quiet and are quiet just like road vehicles. Mr. Joyce asked about the Mud Pit and any kind of screening protection for the audience. Mr. Trivette has double the space that is required for these types of events and has screening in place. Mr. Joyce asked about Mr. Trivette’s land disturbance license and why he had not written his license number in the application. Mr. Trivette explained that he had his license at one point and has reapplied and waiting to be issued his new number that will be coming any day. Mr. Collins asked about the number of estimated vehicles participating and guest arriving to the event and campground. Mr. Trivette responded that he did not know as he doesn’t have a preregistration for the event. Mr. Collins concerned about the mud on tires coming on the public road. Mr. Trivette commented there will be wash station so that vehchiles participating will be able to wash the tires and sides so no mud will spill off in the road. Ms.

Davis asked if there would be any drugs or alcohol at the event and was concerned about sanitation. Ms. Davis inquired whether the Sheriff has been notified of the event. Mr. Trivette will not be selling alcohol on the premises but cannot enforce what the guests bring. He does have porta johns and hand washing stations set up. Mr. Trivette commented that he wanted to see how the meeting would go first before notifying the Sheriff. Ms. Foster asked about security and what he had in place if there was a problem. Mr. Trivette was not concerned about Security because he wasn't going to tolerate bad behavior. Ms. Davis made a comment that Mr. Trivette had already notified EMS. Mr. Trivette listed that the Craig Creep Fire Department would be there, EMS would be there, and he was taking extra precautions. Mr. Trivette said that he knew all his neighbors and met with each neighbor and hopes they are excited about and will come to the event. Ms. Klopfer asked if Mr. Trivette had enough space for parking. Mr. Trivette responded that they have 60 acres and plenty of parking. Mr. Joyce asked about the rating of the bridge. Mr. Trivette said that about 7-8 years ago he drove a loader across it. Never been an issue, most of it perfectly fine. Ms. Klopfer asked if anyone would be driving in the creek. Mr. Trivette said no one would be driving in the creek. Mr. Joyce asked if Emergency Services had any concerns or comments. Mr. Cady commented that Mr. Humphries met with Mr. Trivette, and the only concern was if the crowd grows, additional EMS would be called, and Mr. Trivette was aware of that.

Ms. Klopfer asked if there were any more questions or comments? As there were none, she closed the public hearing at 6:23 pm.

Mr. Collins requested that the motion be made on both dates for June 18th and August 27th, pending that no issues arise at the June 18th event.

Ms. Foster made a motion to accept the application and approve. Mr. Huffman seconded the motion, all in favor, motion passed. Recommended to the Board of Supervisors.

Mr. Spence asked if there were any questions from the board. Mr. Spence did comment on having enough security at event to prevent undue work for the Sheriff's Department.

ACTION AS A RESULT OF PUBLIC HEARING

Mr. Bailey made a motion, Mr. Dunbar Seconded, Mr. Dunbar, yes, Mr. Bailey, yes, and Mr. Spence, yes. Motion passed.

Mr. Spence Adjourned the meeting at 6:28 pm.
