

## CRAIG COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE

### FULL-TIME DISPATCHER

The Craig County Sheriff's Office is seeking applications for the position of Full-Time Dispatcher. Applicants must be 21 years of age and possess a high school diploma or GED equivalent.

Applicants must be willing and available to work all shifts, including nights, weekends, and holidays, however this position is third shift with the hours of 11:00 pm to 9:00 am, and four, ten- hour shifts. Every other month evening shift and midnight dispatcher's alternate shifts for two shifts. The Craig County Sheriff's Office is a 24- hour emergency service and overtime is expected as all three shifts need to be covered. Occasionally you may have to work more than four days in a row.

Successful applicants will be required to undergo comprehensive training and be required to complete basic dispatch school and basic VCIN training, C.P.R. and emergency medical dispatch training as a condition of continued employment. A criminal background check, and drug test is required. Probation for one year upon appointment. Starting pay is \$31,200.00.
